The exporting of THE new vintage has commenced with shipments to China, USA and Australia. Locally the range is just coming into the market.

Pinot Gris 2008



Enjoy the aromas and flavours of orchard pears, figs and quince. Creamy and rich with just enough sweetness and a touch of spice that lingers on the palate..

Pinot Noir 2007



Discover the intensely rich aromas of juicy dark cheery, ripe plum and spicy oak. Loads of flavours, both savoury and sweet. This full-bodied wine has a deliciously soft and silken texture.

Sauvignon Blanc 2008



Plentiful aromas of tropical fruit and freshly chopped capsicum with zesty flavours of ripe fruit salad, just-picked garden herbs and mineral and floral overtones. Classic Marlborough.

Viognier 2008



Lots of peachy, apricot aromas and flavours. This wine feels very rich and weighty. Full-bodied and packed with stone fruits. Very concentrated it has some spicy, toasty characters too.
